**Twitter** --- **Twitter** is an online social networking service that enables users to send and read short 140-character messages called "tweets". Registered users can read and post tweets, but those who are unregistered can only read them.

**Tweet** --- A **Tweet** is any message posted to Twitter which may contain photos, videos, links and up to 140 characters of text.

**Retweet** --- A **Re-tweet** is when someone on Twitter sees your message and decides to re-share it with his or her followers.



**Instagram** --- **Instagram** is a photo sharing application that lets users take photos, apply filters to their images, and share the photos instantly on the Instagram network and other social networks like Facebook, Flickr, Twitter, and Foursquare. The app is targeted toward mobile social sharing, and has gained more than 300 million users.

**Instant Messaging** --- **Instant messaging (IM)** is a form of real-time, direct text-based communication between two or more people. More advanced instant messaging software clients also allow enhanced modes of communication, such as live voice or video calling.

**Facebook** --- **Facebook** is a social media platform. The site connects people with friends, family, acquaintances, and businesses from all over the world and enables them to post, share, and engage with a variety of content such as photos and status updates. The platform currently has around 1.49 billion active users.

**Hashtag** --- **A hashtag** is a tag (#) used on a variety of social networks as a way to annotate a message. A hashtag is a word or phrase preceded by a “#” (such as #InboundMarketing). Social networks use hashtags to categorize information and make it easily searchable for users.

**Chat** --- **Chat** can refer to any kind of communication over the internet but traditionally refers to one-to-one communication through a text-based chat application, commonly referred to as instant messaging (IM) applications.

**Snapchat** --- **Snapchat** is a social app that allows users to send and receive time-sensitive photos and videos known as "snaps," which are hidden from the recipients once the time limit expires (images and videos still remain on the Snapchat server). Users can add text and drawings to their snaps and control the list of recipients in which they send them to.

**App** --- **App** is short for application and is a software program that you use online or on mobile devices to shortcut something you are wanting for convenience or use. You can download an app for the weather, alerts, news, games, etc.

**Blog** --- **Blog** is a word that was created from two words: “web log.” Blogs are usually maintained by an individual or a business with regular entries of content on a specific topic, descriptions of events, or other resources such as graphics or video.

**Live Streaming** --- **Live streaming** is the act of delivering content over the internet in real-time.

**Search Engine** --- **A search engine** is a web-based tool that enables users to locate information on the World Wide Web. Popular examples of **search engines** are Google, Yahoo!, and MSN Search.

**Skype** --- **Skype** is a computer program that can be used to make free voice calls over the Internet to anyone else who is also using **Skype**.
