Let's Get Ahead of the Japanese Beetles

It is often best to put down grub preventers from April through mid-July when grubs are ready to hatch. If you want to stop grub damage right away, the best time to apply a grub killer to your lawn is when you first see signs of damage.

SPRING (April – late May): Apply after ground has thawed to control overwintering grubs that are now migrating to the surface to feed on the roots.

SUMMER (late June – early August): Apply to control newly hatched grub larvae. Should be applied within 2-3 weeks of peak timing for adult beetles.

Golf Carts: There have been several reports about golf carts cutting off other vehicles on the streets, driving in the park, and/or being driven by minors. The board has requested police to patrol for this issue, and a reminder to operate a vehicle you must be 16 years old and have a driver's license. The park is off limits to non-city-operated motorized vehicles, as well as off-leash dogs.

Please: keep up with weed control.

Also, parents, please speak with your children about the inadvisability of ringing doorbells and running away.
