The city's sidewalk task force is reviewing the sidewalk ordinance and may refine the current fee structure to ensure it is applied in a way that is as fair and reasonable as possible.

Don't Be Puffin'



It has been cold and snowy in Denver. It might seem like a good idea to start your car and let it heat up while you go inside and stay warm, but that's actually illegal.

Leaving your car unattended while it's running, aka "puffing", makes you very vulnerable to getting your vehicle stolen. It's part of why Colorado has the highest per capita cartheft rate in the US.

The Denver Police Department said vehicles with a remote start are exempt from this. However, there is an exception: if your vehicle has been idling for longer than 5 minutes, whether on public or private property, it is subject to citation.

(Fun fact: The law was created to protect Colorado's air from harmful emissions, not to protect from potential theft scenarios, according to DPD.)



'Tis The Season for SNOW!

Clear your walks within 24 hours Everyone enjoys safe, clear sidewalks – and it's everyone's responsibility to keep the sidewalks adjacent to their home or business clear and accessible by clearing snow from sidewalks as soon as it's practical and safe.

The city staff keep up with the park as much as possible. With our freeze/thaw cycles, the shaded area at the south side of the walkway, and the tendency for ice buildup at all the park entrances, please always use caution. Call 311 to report hazardous situations.
