Let's Get Ahead of the Japanese Beetles

It is often best to put down grub preventers from April through mid-July when grubs are ready to hatch. If you want to stop grub damage right away, the best time to apply a grub killer to your lawn is when you first see signs of damage.

SPRING (April - late May): Apply after ground has thawed to control overwintering grubs that are now migrating to the surface to feed on the roots. SUMMER (late June – early August): Apply to control newly hatched grub larvae. Should be applied within 2-3 weeks of peak timing for adult beetles.
